 - d. MU Challenge – add announcement to C4 website asking for volunteers and participant support for the event.
 - e. Competition Event – Tour de Moore Road Race
 - i. Todd Stout, Mac Canon, Judy and John Muller and Richard Kirby are on the race committee.
 - ii. C4 is now the primary listing on the permit. C4 is asking for volunteers to help support this great event. **We need as many volunteers as we can muster.**
 - Bob will serve as assistant judge or possible rover in a chase vehicle.
 - They would like for us to provide at least 5 volunteers if not more. Race experience is preferred but not needed. They mainly need course marshals.
 - If we can find a wheel truck and someone to help drive it, that would be a plus and would help out John Muller.
 - iii. It is looking like the course will start and stop at the Campbell house but run through town out towards Woodlake, around Woodlake a few times and then back in. Categories are as follows:

 - 40+
 - 50+

 - Womens 3/4
 - Juniors can race whatever category they want for free.
- 3. Saturday Ride Ability Groups – Richard Kirby
